



Fort Smith Downtown Locator Map

Historic downtown Fort Smith clusters a diversity of local eateries, shopping, entertainment, businesses, lodging and tourist sites within a few accessible city blocks. Pick up walking or driving tour brochures at Miss Laura's Visitor's Center, a restored former bordello, and then visit the National Historic Site, complete with the Hanging Judge's infamous gallows. Fort Smith's oldest street, Garrison Avenue, has 14 blocks of shopping and dining, and the adjacent Belle Grove Historic District features quaint Victorian architecture along the original brick-lined streets. Easily access the rest of Fort Smith via Rogers Avenue, the city's major thoroughfare, which runs from downtown more than 100 blocks to the city's eastern border.
